**AWARD-WINNING KICKAPOO/CREEK ACTRESS
ARIGON STARR BRINGS "THE RED ROAD" TO TULSA**
One-Woman Play Features Comedy, Music and Contemporary Native America

October 2, 2007 - Los Angeles, CA - Arigon Starr, an award-winning singer-songwriter, actress and playwright, returns to Tulsa's Gilcrease Museum to perform her one-woman show "The Red Road" on November 8, 9 and 10 at 7:30pm. Tickets are \$10 for the general public, \$8 for museum members and free to high school and college students with school I.D.

"The Red Road" tells the story of a fictional truck stop/diner in Sapulpa, Oklahoma that hosts the taping of the tenth anniversary of "The Patty Jones Show." Audiences looking for comedy, country music and the heart of Native America will find it in abundance at "The Red Road." Starr portrays eleven different characters and performs ten original songs that both the *Los Angeles Times* and *Daily Variety* called "witty, insightful and lively."

The play is produced by Native Voices at the Autry, a theater company based in Los Angeles dedicated to developing new work from Native American writers. The show premiered in Los Angeles and has been performed in New York and Washington, DC. "The Red Road" will be performed at the ASSITEJ World Theater Network for Children and Young People's Festival in Adelaide, Australia in May 2008, the only play representing North America. Starr is the first Native American performer ever featured at the prestigious event.

Arigon Starr's music for "The Red Road" has been recognized with an award from First Americans in the Arts, three Native American Music Award nominations and a nomination for "Best County CD" from the Aboriginal Peoples Choice Awards in Canada.
